

In Case of a Power Outage...

FIRST- If there are numbers on your digital meter, that indicates you have power to your meter. In this case you need to contact an electrician.

SECOND - Check your own fuses or circuit breakers. If we are called to your home and the problem is a tripped breaker or blown fuse on your side of the meter, you will be assessed a trip charge.
